What to say example: HELLO my name is lilo. I'm here with AGORA Ministries. We are having a party in the park for the kids at 1:00p.m. We would love to see you there. We will have crafts, games, food, and Jesus! HOPE TO SEE YOU THERE!

- **SMILE!** When approaching the apartment doors smile. Face the door at all times, never turn your back to the door. You wouldn't answer the door to someone's face you couldn't see.
  - **BUDDIES!** All girl knocking groups will be accompanied by a minimum of one male. NO ONE male or female will walk alone. Ohana means family, and family means no one is left behind or forgotten. We will be serving in a rough area, be aware of your surroundings.
  - **EXCITABILITY!** Be excited about the event you are asking the community to attend. No one wants to go to a boring party, Get Pumped!
  - **NO ENTRANCE!** For safety reason you will never enter a home or accept a drink or snack from any home. Politely say "no thank you" and remind them there will be snacks and drinks at our event.
  - **RESPECT!** The door are very thin please be respectful and represent Christ in your speech as you walk around the apartment property.

- Bible Lesson: The Christmas Story/ The Good News (10 minutes)
  - Luke 2:1-20 , A 10 Minute lesson on the Christmas story, and what that means for our kids, the greatest gift of all.
- Object Lesson: Candy Cane Meaning (10 minutes)
  - Stripes for the blood shed on the cross, cane in the way Jesus guides us, white in the purity of our savior.
  - Poem: Look at the candy cane what do you see? Stripes that are red like his blood shed for me. White for my savior who's sinless and pure. "J" is for Jesus, my Lord that's for sure! Turn it around and a staff you will see Jesus my shepherd is coming for me!
- Large Group Craft: Candy Cane Reindeer (15 minutes)
  - Bags of craft supplies will be passed to each child. Volunteers will spread themselves amongst the children to help each child complete his or her craft
- Prayer over the Children, option for salvation prayer
- Volunteers form a Cheer tunnel by standing parallel to one another arms raised, hands touching.
